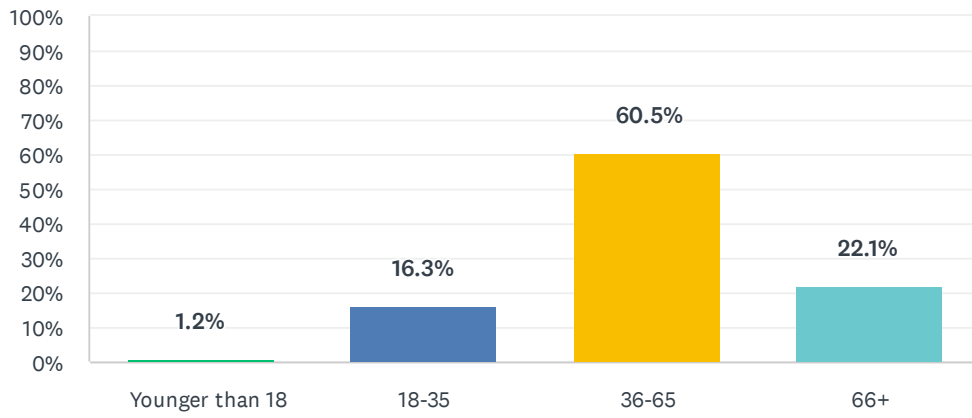


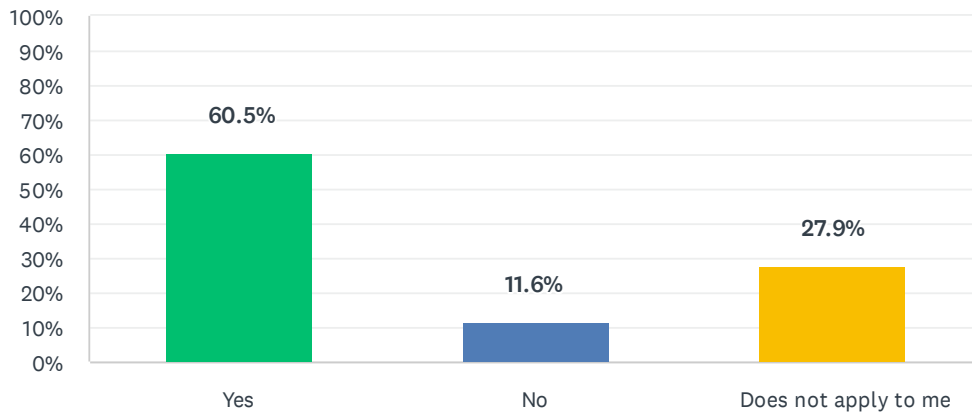

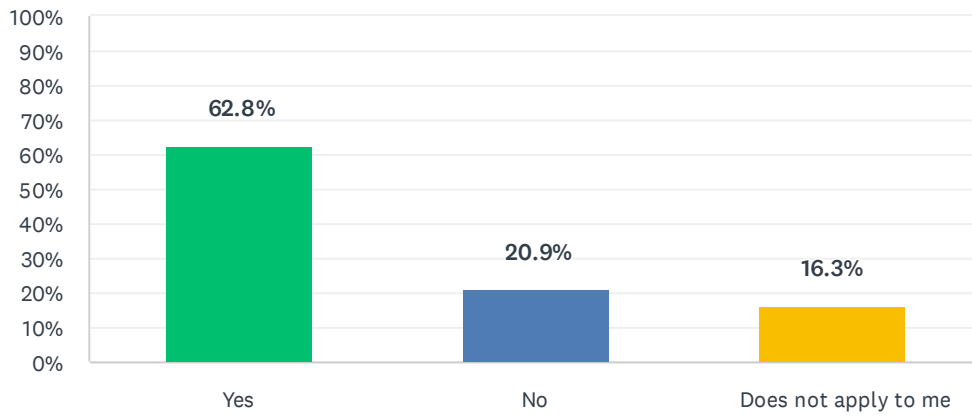
Q3 Would you bring children to the new Blue River Park?

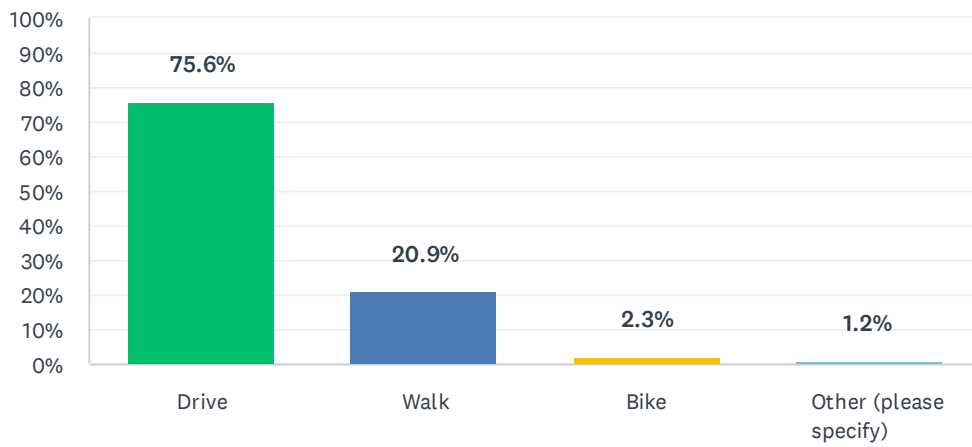
Q4 Would you bring dogs to the new Blue River Park?

Q5 How will you primarily get to Blue River Park?

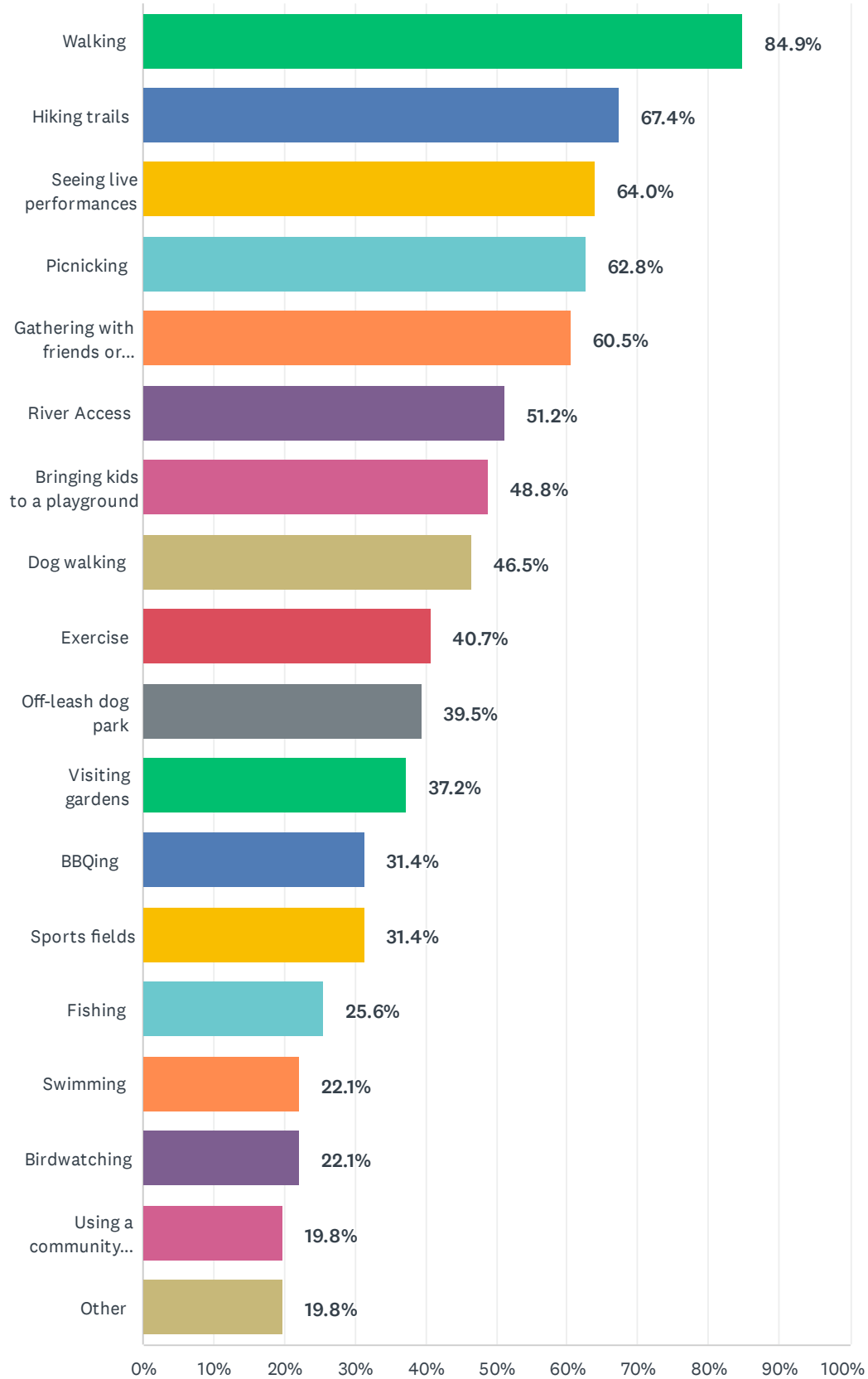
